Ohio Chamber PAC backs Cupp, O'Donnell for Re-election to Ohio Supreme Court

Two current Justices are part of a Court that has Improved Ohio's Legal Climate

Columbus – The Ohio Chamber of Commerce Political Action Committee (OCCPAC) today announced its endorsement of Justices Robert Cupp and Terrence O'Donnell for re-election to the Ohio Supreme Court in 2012. Both Justices have previously received the support of the OCCPAC.

“Throughout their respective tenures on the Ohio Supreme Court, Robert Cupp and Terrence O'Donnell have repeatedly demonstrated the judicial restraint that gives Ohioans certainty that law will be created in the legislature and not from the bench,” said Andrew E.
