# **Navigating CBD Questions**

The Variables

- Chemical found in cannabis plants (e.g., marijuana and hemp).
- Used for conditions such as anxiety, depression and pain.
- One CBD product, Epidiolex®, has been FDA-approved to treat two rare forms of epilepsy.
- Non-prescription CBD products are applied topically, smoked, vaped or ingested.



# Laws & Regulations

#### Marijuana (source plant)

- Federally illegal per Controlled Substances Act.
- Legal for recreational and/or medical use according to state-specific laws.

#### Hemp (source plant)

- 2018 Farm Bill removed hemp from the Controlled Substances Act.
- States are responsible for enacting laws to legalize use and cultivation within their borders.
- FDA responsible for approving for medical use (only Epidiolex® has received approval).

# **THC Content**

#### CBD Extracted from Marijuana

- · Could contain high levels of THC.
- Could cause a high.
- Could trigger a positive drug test.

#### CBD Extracted from Hemp

- Contains less than 0.3% THC.
- Not likely to cause a high.
- Not likely to trigger a positive drug test.

# Label Dependability

#### Online

A 2017 study on CBD products purchased online found 70% did not contain the amount of CBD listed on the label and 20% contained THC.

# Dispensaries

Most marijuana dispensaries also sell CBD products. These businesses must follow state laws and are likely required to verify their products only contain what is listed on the labels.

## Retail Stores

Unless subject to state oversight, retailers are reliant on manufacturer claims regarding the source of CBD and specific product content.
